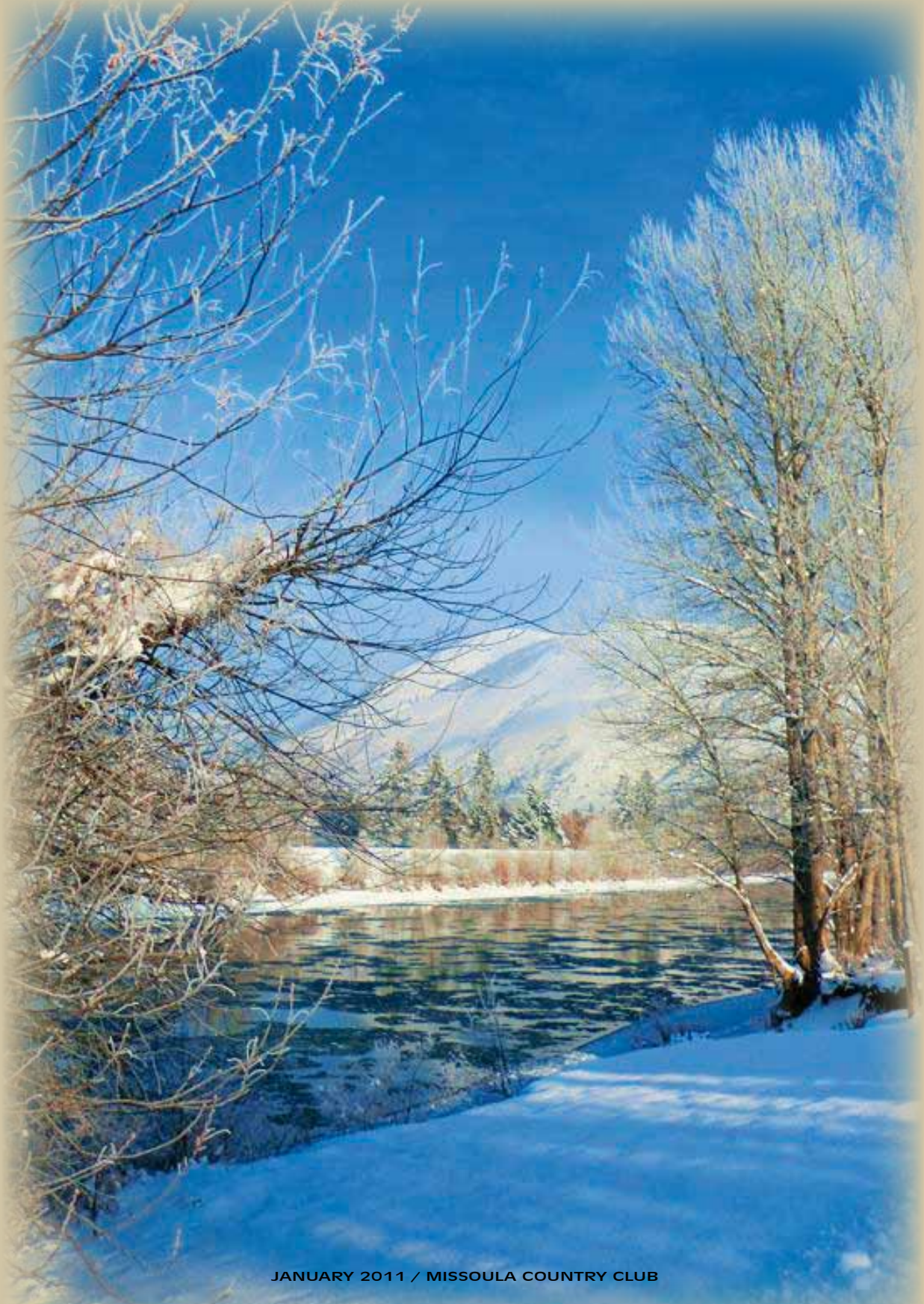

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Questions About Events:

Happy New Year! 2011 will be a time for new beginnings and new events to plan in the Food & Beverage Department. I am starting to schedule Weddings for next summer and several other events as well. If you have any questions or know of anyone interested in planning an event here at the Club, hopefully this will answer some of those questions. If not, feel free to stop in or give me a call anytime at 251-2404.

Frequently asked questions:

1. *Do I have to be a member of the Missoula Country Club to have my event there?*

No, if you are not a member of the Missoula Country Club and you do not know a Member, we will find a member to “sponsor” your event for you.

2. *Is there a room service charge?*

If you are a current member of the Missoula Country Club there is no charge for the use of the facilities. If you are not a member, a fee of \$500.00 per room is charged.

3. *How many people can you accommodate for an event in the Missoula Country Club Clubhouse?*

We can accommodate a party of 150 people inside the Clubhouse, and parties up to 350 people in an event tent outside.

4. *If I would like to have a small event, are there a minimum number of people I must have in order to host my event at the Missoula Country Club?*

Absolutely not, we will accommodate groups of any size, 2 people to 350 people.



5. *What is a member sponsor and do they have to be present during my event?*

A member sponsor is a current member of the Missoula Country Club who agrees to allow you access to the event facilities of the Missoula Country Club under their membership. They do not have to be present for the event; however, they will be billed for the event.

Private Parties: Members may arrange for private parties with the Food and Beverage Director. The fee for use of any of the facilities, i.e., dance floor, patio, dining room, Miller Barber Library, shall be set by the General Manager. Party contracts will hold the member responsible for the bill with a 50% deposit on all functions that are estimated to be in excess of \$1,000. This deposit can be waived for members in good standing. If canceled, those monies may not be refunded. That will be up to the General Manager based on documented expenses.

- A. Wedding receptions at the Club are restricted to immediate family members during the peak season. Immediate family members are fathers and mothers, sons and daughters, brothers and sisters, nieces and nephews, and grandchildren of regular or social members. Wedding receptions for friends of members may be sponsored by a member in the off season, September through April.
- B. The Club will not confirm a date for a non-member function prior to six months before the event date. This is to allow Club and member functions to have priority on the calendar.

We are very flexible and will work around people's budget restrictions in regards to deposits and event fees.
